**Eligibility:**

Students must be 9<sup>th</sup> to 12<sup>th</sup> graders next fall. Residence in the Alhambra Unified School District is not required for participation and qualified students from private, parochial, and public schools from surrounding communities are invited to apply. Students must have met the prerequisites noted in the course list in order to register for the class. Non-Alhambra District students should check with their schools to ensure that credit earned for the course work will be accepted.

**Attendance and Behavior Standards:**

Students are expected to adhere to reasonable behavior standards and the attendance policy in order to receive credit. Students who choose to create discipline problems will be dismissed from the program and tuition will be forfeited.

**Transportation:**

No school bus transportation is provided.

**Tuition:**

Tuition is payable at time of registration. Cash, checks, Money Orders, MasterCard/Visa/American Express are acceptable forms of payment, made payable to Alhambra Educational Foundation. A service charge of \$25.00 will be assessed for any checks returned.

**Refunds:**

All requests for refunds must be submitted on the "Financial Adjustment Form" available from the Foundation Office. Full refund for tuition-based classes will only be made for cancelled classes. Partial refunds will be made upon receipt of the Financial Adjustment Form in the Foundation office by the following schedule:

On or before May 18, 2010	\$25 Cancellation Fee
May 25, 2010 to May 28, 2010	\$50 Cancellation Fee
June 1, 2010 to June 11, 2010	50% Refund of Total Tuition

After June 15, 2010, refund requests will be reviewed for approval for verifiable emergencies only. All refunds must be approved by the on-site administrator. **Students dismissed for disciplinary reasons will forfeit complete tuition.** Refunds will be processed within three weeks of receipt of the Financial Adjustment Form. **Classes with insufficient enrollment will be cancelled and full tuition for these students will be refunded.**

**Report Cards/Transcripts:**

All Alhambra Unified District high school students will have their summer course grades credit automatically posted to their transcripts. Grades will be posted to the student's transcript in time for their counselor to make any necessary fall schedule adjustments. Non-Alhambra District students may request verification of their credited course grade be sent to their home or school. Students taking a 10 unit (two semesters) "progressive academic discipline" course such as Biology, Chemistry, Geometry, Algebra II or Trigonometry and fail the First Semester, which is the first three weeks of the six week summer session, may be dropped from the class for the Second Semester. **There is no refund.**

**Attendance Policy:**

In order to satisfy class requirements, students must be present and on time each day. You may be dropped from class following a 4<sup>th</sup> absence regardless of the reason for the absences.

**Please note:**

SAT Prep and CAHSEE Prep classes will be offered in the afternoon. Students may enroll for a ten unit class in the morning and enroll for the SAT Prep or CAHSEE Prep class in the afternoon. A short lunch break between classes will be provided.
